- Children and Hoosiers Immunization Registry Program
- Real-time – no delay
- Contains information on:
 - Immunizations
 - WIC enrollment
 - Lead testing
- Available to local health departments

- Transition from a comprehensive Childhood Lead Poisoning Prevention Program to a Healthy Homes Program
- Strategic retreat being held on January 11, 2001
- Moderated by the National Center for Healthy Homes' Executive Director, Rebecca Morley

Radon Program

- Moving under the Indiana Lead and Healthy Homes Program
- Increase awareness about radon
- Increase testing for elevated radon levels
- Holistic healthy homes approach

Proposed Indoor Air Quality Rule

- Indiana Administrative Code 410, Chapter 33
- Establishes an indoor air quality program to:
 - Determine when to inspect a property
 - Determine best practices
 - Determine necessary minimum standards for IAQ in schools and state agencies
 - Develop a parent and employee notification program
